JOHN FINNEY Conductor of The University Chorale of Boston College

Now in his 29th year as Conductor of the University Chorale, John Finney has proudly conducted the Chorale in many ambitious and successful musical seasons at Boston College, and in performances in locations throughout the world, ranging from Fenway Park in Boston to a private audience with His Holiness Pope John Paul II in the Vatican City. His ability to showcase the glorious sound of the full Chorale while emphasizing the importance of each individual member has long entranced singers and audience members alike.

Finney has been recognized as one of the finest and most versatile musicians in the Boston area. In 1999, he was appointed conductor of the Boston College Symphony Orchestra, and given the title of Distinguished Artist-in-Residence at Boston College.

He has served as Director of Music at the Wellesley Hills Congregational Church for 37 years, and was the Conductor of the Heritage Chorale in Framingham for more than 33 years. He has performed as Conductor at the acclaimed Bach Festival in Blue Hill, Maine since 2013. He was Associate Conductor and Chorusmaster of Boston's Handel & Haydn Society for many years; he previously served on the organ faculty of The Boston Conservatory, and taught at the Academy for Early Music in Bressanone, Italy. In recognition of his outstanding contributions to choral music in New England, he received the Alfred Nash Patterson Lifetime Achievement Award for 2020 from Choral Arts New England.
